Who We Are

First Tee is a youth development organization that impacts the lives of young people by providing programs focused on building character and instilling life-enhancing values, through the game of golf.

At First Tee – Metropolitan New York ("FTMNY"), our chapter aspires to empower resilient and diverse leaders by providing educational and career **opportunities** to underserved youth throughout metropolitan New York. We do this by using golf as a vehicle to partner students with coaches and peers who are invested in their long-term development and success. We prioritize making a lasting impact on our students by dedicating time both in the classroom and on the course, delivering comprehensive and impactful seven-week program experiences that uniquely blend golf and academics.

Our History

FTMNY has been fostering the inner strength of kids aged 5-18 since its establishment in 2001, making it one of the longest-standing chapters in First Tee's now expansive network of ~150 chapters. Over the last 24 years, our chapter has undergone significant transformation and growth to best serve our community; we are now operating across seven campus locations in the tri-state area.

Now more than ever, FTMNY plays a critical role in the community given the many challenges facing today's youth.

Challenges Facing Today's Youth

Our kids and teens are facing challenges unseen by previous generations. Many lack access to safe opportunities that provide mentorship and foster a culture of acceptance. They live in a world where social pressures are always on, and calm and confidence are hard to access.

- Only 24% of U.S. youth meet the CDC'S recommended physical activity guidelines
- Nearly **8 million** children do not have a safe, supervised environment from 3 –6PM
- 1 out of 3 young Americans will grow up without a mentor
- > Students who participate in **structured youth programs** like First Tee report higher self-confidence, responsibility, and resilience
- Most parents agree that **sports can be a valuable tool** for improving children's mental health, creating opportunities to learn life skills, as well as providing supportive adults to help strengthen a child's character development.







Path to College ("PTC") Overview

One of FTMNY's most remarkable strengths is **Path to College** — our signature, flagship program and a cornerstone of our mission. Exclusive to First Tee — Met NY, this year-round academic enrichment initiative is unlike anything offered at other First Tee chapters. Path to College allows us to truly shape the lives of our students by providing consistent, long-term academic and social-emotional support at every age level, from 7 to 18. It reflects our deep commitment to walking alongside each child as they progress through school and prepare for life beyond.

2024 PTC Program Highlights:

- Ace Scholars: Supporting 62 dedicated middle school students through <u>100+ hours</u> of intensive learning, one-on-one counseling, and assistance for high school and college applications.
- Individual Tutoring & SAT Prep: Helping 58 First Tee participants to enhance their comprehension, boost their scores, foster essential learning skills and gain confidence in academics through <u>year-round assistance</u>.
- **Summer STEAM Academy:** Providing **168** participants an opportunity to delve into STEAM, Coding, and Literacy in a fun and engaging way, showcasing a **63**% improvement in STEM skills.
- High School & College Acceptance Counseling: With a 100% graduate rate, over \$700,000 in scholarships earned over 14 years, and more, we offer additional on-site, one-on-one counseling at First Tee to guide our participants in the school search and application processes.

PTC Director – Karen Les Pierre:

In 2012, Karen LesPierre partnered with First Tee to help tutor students part time. Shortly thereafter, she became a full-time member of the First Tee family where she helped revamp FTMNY's now flagship PTC program. Karen feels proud to have impacted so many students through PTC and emphasizes the impact it has on a FTMNY student's trajectory.




Coach Spotlight - Callen Williams:
